The Award is the highest recognition conferred on exceptional students by the UAE. Winners Anupama Avarankunnathu Padincharethil of Grade 9G1, Christina Mary Rajan of Grade 4G1 and Aashay Jain of Grade 4B2 were recognized with this highly coveted award for their outstanding academic achievements, talents, skills and leadership abilities. Apart from giving the students a huge sense of accomplishment, it has encouraged them to set their goals higher and accomplish more. We are delighted that in the Grade 3 to 5 category, of the 3 students from Indian curriculum schools who won the award. 2 were ours! In the Grade 6 to 12 category, of the 4 students from Indian curriculum schools who won the award, 1 was ours!

We are celebrating the Overall Trophy our students lifted at the Hindi Pratibha Sangam. The competition was tough with over 50 schools participating but that did not deter our students. Swastika Dash of Grade 9G received the First Prize for Poem Recitation, Shriya Jishnu of Grade 8G2 received the Second Prize for Advertisement and Pranay Bapna of Grade 10B1 received the Third Prize in Poem Recitation. The students were commended for their fine performance, confidence and fluency in the language.

Continuing this winning streak were Syed Saad Shakir of Grade 8B2 (First Prize) and Syed Yasir Ahmed of Grade 6B1 (Third Prize) at the Quran Hifdh and Recitation Competition organized by Al Amana Private school Sharjah. **EDITION #14**

A strong mind starts with a fit body

Our thoughts, feelings, beliefs, and attitudes can positively or negatively affect our biological functioning. On the other hand, what we do with our physical body can impact our mental state (again positively or negatively).

Here are some tips to practice :

A fit body helps a fit mind!

Exercise regularly. Choose whatever you enjoy most – go for a walk, run, swim, perform yoga, join a dance class, exercise with a friend that can make the activity more fun, as well as provide additional motivation.

Practice Mindfulness

Mindfulness involves observing your thoughts, feelings and breath. As a quick exercise, sit with your feet flat on the ground and your back straight but not touching the back of the chair. Set your phone timer to a countdown of 90 seconds. Rest your right hand in your left hand and close your eyes. Breathe a little slower and more deliberately than normal, and feel the air entering and exiting your nose, your chest slowly rising and falling. When your mind wanders, silently acknowledge it and be proud that you noticed, then return to focusing on your breaths, in and out.

If you don't snooze, you lose!

Make time for sleep. To work at your best, you need your rest. It can be hard to get to sleep when you're feeling stressed or have had your brain switched on all day studying. Unwind before bed by listening to soft music or if you find yourself thinking about your work, jot it down on a notepad for the morning

Treat yourself (to something healthy, of course)!

Choose delicious but nutritious snacks. It's great to have scrumptious edible rewards while studying, but try not to dig out just on chips and biscuits. Almonds, cut fruits with a few scoops of unsweetened yoghurt and dark chocolate are some good options.

Don't be too hard on yourself!

There's no point berating yourself if you didn't get through as much work as you hoped to. You can only do the best you can, with what you've got right now .
