

At GEMS Millennium School, Sharjah, we have very purposefully built a *win-win* culture. In business, the term 'win-win' generally refers to strategies that allow "both, or all, parties involved in a negotiation or another activity to be successful to a degree." In the context of our school, this translates to seeing school life as a cooperative arena, and not a competitive one. Most of us learn to base our self-worth on comparisons and competition. We think about succeeding in terms of someone else failing—if I win, you lose; or if you win, I lose. Life becomes a zero-sum game. There is only so much pie to go around, and if you get a big piece, there is less for me; it's not fair, and I'm going to make sure you don't get any more. We all play the game, but how much fun is it really?



In our school, win-win is a frame of mind and heart that constantly seeks mutual benefit in all human interactions. Win-win means agreements or solutions are mutually beneficial and satisfying. Both get to eat the pie, and it tastes pretty darn good!

To go for a win-win, you not only have to be empathic, but you also have to be confident. You not only have to be considerate and sensitive, but you also have to be brave. That balance between courage and consideration is the essence of real maturity and is fundamental to win-win.

Many people think in terms of either/or: either you're nice or you're tough. Win-win requires that you be both. It is a balancing act between courage and consideration.

There are three vital character traits that are essential to this paradigm:

Integrity: i.e. sticking with your true feelings, values, and commitments.

**Maturity:** i.e. expressing your ideas and feelings with courage and consideration for the ideas and feelings of others.

Abundance Mentality: i.e. believing there is plenty for everyone.

A win-win approach to teaching is really about being able to think, plan, and make decisions in ways that take the needs of others into consideration—our students, certainly, as well as other members of the school community. Win-win strategies amongst others help by:-

• establishing the teacher's authority without disempowering students and building students' independence, self-management, and accountability;

• defusing conflicts and in-your-face challenges while focusing on the positive aspects of students' behavior and work;

- matching instruction to students' needs and learning styles and engaging the whole range of students, including defiant, defeated, and at-risk learners;
- accommodating students' needs for autonomy and the ability to influence their learning;
- accommodating students' needs for respect, acceptance, and belonging;
- accommodate students' needs for success and competence, as well as honest feedback and continual, appropriate challenge and creating an emotionally safe classroom environment;
- encouraging positive social interactions among students;
- building positive, supportive relationships with teachers, mentors, administrators, and peers.

At school, we start by doing what's necessary, then what's possible, and suddenly we are achieving the impossible.


