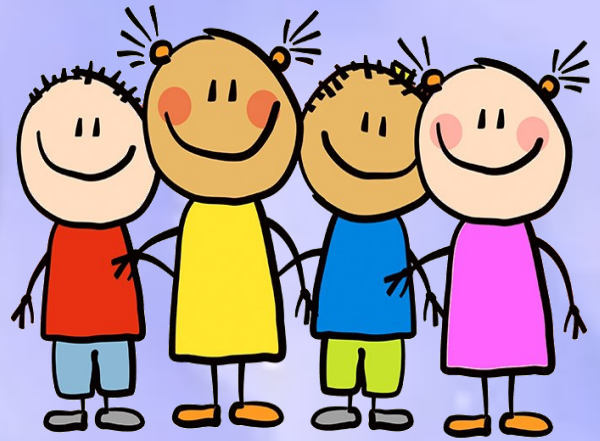
WELL DONE!

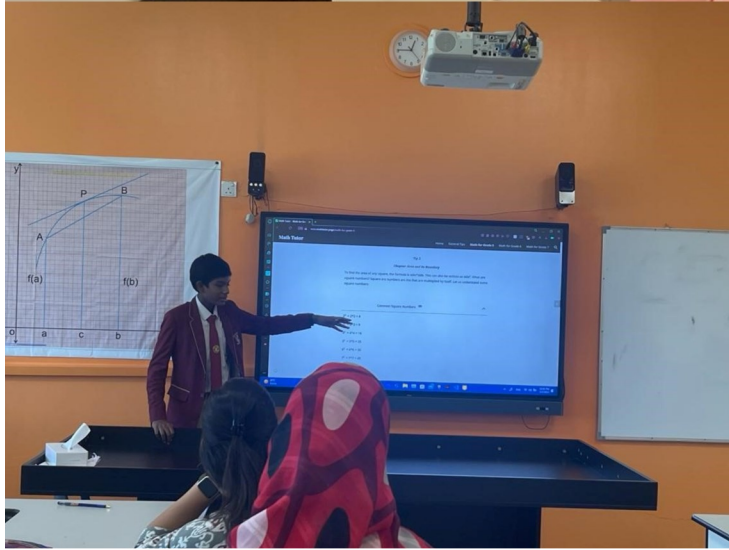
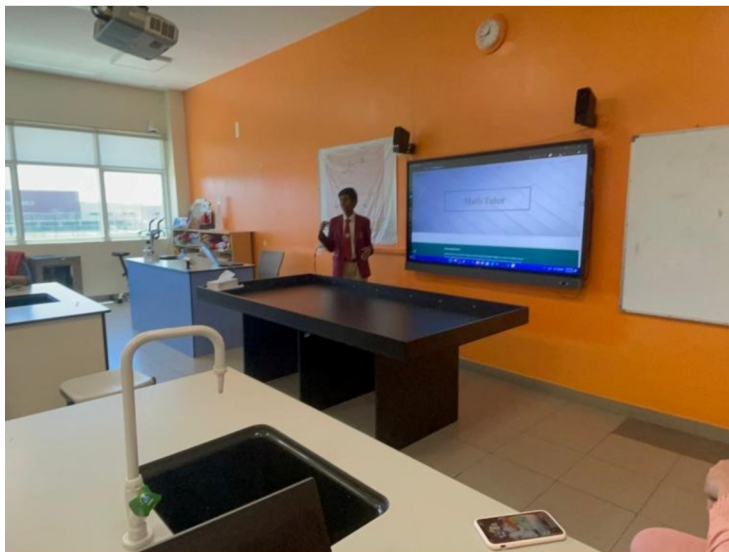
