The target of the **UAE National Agenda** 2021 is to be among the 20 highest performing countries in PISA.


Every PISA test assesses students' knowledge and skills in reading, mathematics and science;

each assessment focuses on one of these subjects and provides a summary assessment of the other two.


In 2018, the focus was on reading in a digital environment.

#### School results




Our School scores compare positively in the context of UAE Schools and the International benchmark.




When compared to top ranked countries in the world, in Reading we rank third (i.e. below Singapore)




We rank 12<sup>th</sup> in Mathematics (i.e. above Canada)
