COUNSELORS CORNER!

Let's make it personal and let's honestly reflect... Let's start with just one (but major for us) aspect of the internet- social media.

Social media offers several avenues of interactions through social networks (such as Facebook, Snapchat,Instagram etc.). As per the Adobe 2013 Mobile Consumer Survey (2013) social media is the # 1 mobile activity today. A study by Suliveres (2014) has shown that face to face interactions are becoming less important, and a more common method of interpersonal communication especially amongst the youth. Teenagers are one of the most prolific users (Ahn, 2011). In fact, another research study by (Newham, 2012) mentioned that even during face to face interactions, people frequently check for updates (on social media), interrupting the communication.

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR YOU? KEEP AN EYE OUT FOR -Here are some warning signs you might be heading towards an addiction to or a dependency on the internet:

In terms of time, if you find yourself

- unable to limit the amount of time spent on the internet
- sneaking online when an adult isn't watching
- lying about the amount of time you spend
- staying up all night at times, doing something on the web

In terms of emotions, you find yourself

- Getting easily agitated when interrupted
- Getting annoyed when access to the Web is denied
- Becoming moody, irritable, and/or depressed when offline for a couple of days or even hours

In terms of social life, you find yourself

- Checking social media accounts frequently throughout the day
- Preferring online interactions over in person time with friends and family
- Sacrificing school work or house chores, for being on the internet
- Losing interest in the activities you previously enjoyed
