- ◆ We choose our language and the focus of our remarks carefully.
- ◆ We model empathy, create class traditions and tell personal stories.

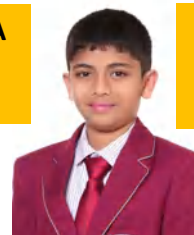

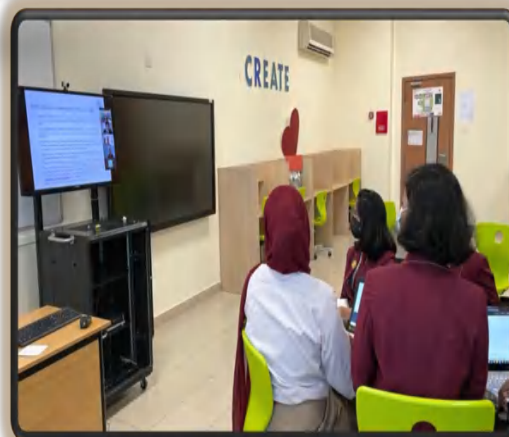
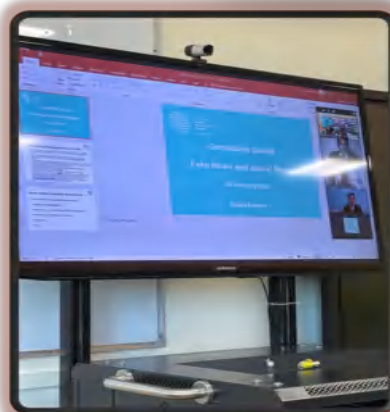
